

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS OF USE CAREFULLY BEFORE USING 101 MAGAZINES INTERNET SITE. ANY FAILURE ON YOUR PART TO COMPLY WITH THESE CONDITIONS OF USE MAY LEAD TO THE CANCELLATION OF YOUR ACCOUNT AND THE RELATED PRIVILEGES.

#### 1. ACCEPTANCE OF CONDITIONS OF USE

1.1. By using one of 101 Publishing Inc. Internet site, you acknowledge having read and understood these conditions of use and, accordingly, you agree to abide by them as well as any future modifications which may be made. These conditions of use represent an agreement between you and 101 Publishing Inc.

Any acts which may infringe other peoples' rights or their enjoyment of the chat rooms or bulletin boards are also prohibited.
